ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Nariyoshi Shinomiya, residing at Apt # 6-804, 3-2 Namiki, Tokorozawa, Saitama 359-0042, Japan (hereinafter referred to as Assignor), has invented certain new and useful improvements in *c-met* siRNA ADENOVIRUS VECTORS INHIBIT CANCER CELL GROWTH, INVASION AND TUMORIGENICITY for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on September 26, 2006 and assigned Application No. 10/599,327.
