NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual benefits accruing to the Assignor and the Assignee hereunder, the execution and delivery of a Bill of Sale, Assignment and Assumption Agreement of even date herewith from Assignor to Assignee, and other good and valuable consideration paid to Assignor, the legal and equitable owner and holder of the Patents (as hereinafter defined), Assignor hereby grants, assigns and conveys to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the patent applications and patents listed in Schedule A (collectively, the "Patents"), including (a) all proceeds (such as, by way of example, license royalties and proceeds of infringement suits), (b) the right to sue for past, present and future infringements, (c) all rights relating to the Patents throughout the world, and (d) all reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions, and continuations-in-part of the Patents, and Assignor hereby releases all rights, titles, interests, claims, liens and equities that Assignor may have or to which Assignor may be entitled related to the Patents. Assignor hereby acknowledges and agrees that its intention is to hereby vest in Assignee full title to all patent applications and patents which are currently held by Assignor, and all rights, titles, interests, claims, liens and equities that Assignor may have or to which Assignor may be entitled related thereto.





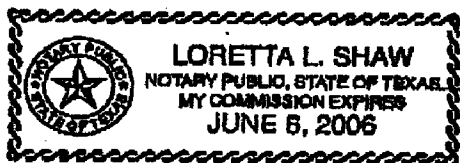
