ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, John C. 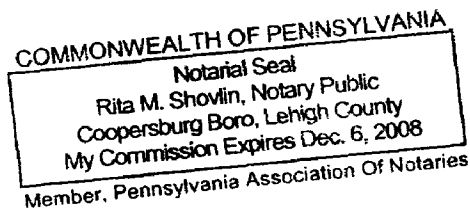

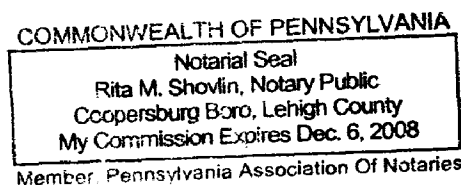
