- 6) authorize and request my representative to insert above the U.S. patent application serial number and the filing date in order to comply with the recordation of this assignment.

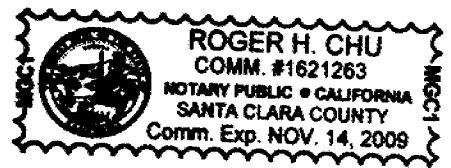
