ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Marta Norton De Matos, a citizen of Portugal and residing at Rua do Prior, no. 15, 1 esq., Lisboa 1200-775, Portugal; and Carlos C. 2. Authorize ASSIGNEE to file patent applications in any or all countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries in our name or in the name of ASSIGNEE or otherwise as ASSIGNEE may deem advisable, under International Conventions or otherwise;
3.
