ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Rajiv Pethe, a resident of 707 Continental Circle, Apt. 731, Mountain View, California 94040, Michael A. Tseng, a resident of 41554 Higgins Way, Fremont, California 94539, Neil Bergstrom, a resident of 530 Marion Avenue, Palo Alto, California 94301, and Julius Kozak, a resident of 4505 Steed Way, Antioch, California 94531, hereinafter referred to as Assignors, have co-invented certain new and useful improvements in an invention entitled FABRICATION OF CONDUCTIVE MICRO TRACES USING A DEFORM AND SELECTIVE REMOVAL PROCESS, for which an application for Letters Patent is filed concurrently herewith in the United States Patent and Trademark Office, present identified as Attorney Docket No. SWL-025N;

interference proceedings involving said invention and/or said improvements and in the adjudication of said Letters Patent, particularly by the disclosure of facts and the production of evidence relating to said invention and/or said improvements, provided the expenses which may be incurred by said Assignors in lending such assistance and cooperation shall be paid by the Assignee.

3. The terms, covenants and conditions of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and/or other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon said Assignors, their heirs, legal representatives and assigns.






