ASSIGNMENT OF UNITED STATES PATENTS

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF UNITED STATES PATENTS (hereinafter, the "Agreement"), dated as of June 8, 2007, is by and between OPHOLIO, INCORPORATED, a Delaware Corporation having its principal place of business at 20 Depot Street, Suite 2A, Peterborough, NH 03458 (hereinafter, the "Assignor"), and FOTOMEDIA TECHNOLOGIES, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company having its principal place of business at 155 Fleet Street, Portsmouth, New Hampshire, 03801 (hereinafter, the "Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of United States Patents No. 6,018,774, titled "Method And System For Creating Messages Including Image Information," issued on January 25, 2000, and No. 6,542,936, titled "System For Creating Messages Including Image Information," issued on April 1, 2003 (hereinafter, the "Assigned Patents"); and

WHEREAS, Assignor desires to assign and Assignee desires to acquire all of Assignor's right, title, and interest in and to the Assigned Patents, subject to the terms of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Assignor has sold, assigned, transferred, and set over, and by these presents does sell, assign, transfer, and set over, unto the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, the entire right, title, and interest in and to the Assigned Patents, the entire right, title, and interest in and to any and all applications for Letters Patent of the United States of America or other countries claiming priority to said Assigned Patents, including divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, and foreign equivalents filed under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the entire right, title, and interest in and to any and all Letters Patents of the United States of America or other countries that may be granted therefor and thereon, including any and all reissues, reexaminations, renewals, substitutions, and extensions of said Letters Patents or Assigned Patents, and together with all claims of Assignor for profits and damages by reason of past infringement, if any, of said Letters Patents or Assigned Patents, with, to the extent transferable, the right to sue for and collect such profits and damages, the same to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee for its own use and behoof and the use and behoof of its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, to the full end of the term or terms for which said Letters Patents or Assigned Patents may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignor had this sale and assignment not been made;

AND for the same consideration, the Assignor hereby covenants and agrees to and with the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, that, at the time of execution and delivery of these presents, the Assignor is the sole and lawful owner of the entire right, title, and interest in and to the Assigned Patents, and that the same are unencumbered, and that the Assignor has good and full right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same in the manner herein set forth.

Assignor hereby authorizes the Commissioner for Patents to record this Agreement.
