The unlimited claim in and to the Invention by **Lars Konig** on **February 20, 2003** also claimed without limitation the right, title and interest to any and all divisions and continuations of the above-referenced patent application, or said counterpart foreign patent applications, or reissues or extensions of

said letters patent or patents, including the right to claim for any such application, all benefits and priority rights under any applicable convention.
