WHEREAS, WE, RICHARD REDIGER, a citizen of United States residing at 2117 Flat Shoals Road, Conyers, Georgia 30094; MICHAEL J. declarations relating to said invention and/or Application, and to testify in any judicial or administrative proceeding and generally do everything possible to aid GPC to secure full and complete protection for the invention and/or Application or that may be necessary to vest in GPC the complete title to the invention and/or Application hereby conveyed and to enable it to record said title and enforce said Letters Patent in the United States or any foreign country when requested so to do by GPC.
