WHEREAS, we, Joseph D. Brennan of Shoreline, Washington and a citizen of US; George D. Hempstead of Camano Island, Washington and a citizen of US; Darrell D. Jones of Mill Creek, Washington and a citizen of US; Matthew K. Lum of Mercer Island, Washington and a citizen of US; Peter D. McCowin of Enumclaw, Washington and a citizen of US; Terrence J. Rowe of Seattle, Washington and a citizen of US; and Hugh R. Schlosstein of Renton, Washington and a citizen of US (hereinafter referred to as "Assignors") have invented certain new and useful improvements in "METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR LAYUP PLACEMENT", (hereinafter "invention") for which Assignors are making or have made application for LETTERS PATENT OF THE UNITED STATES, which application has been duly executed by Assignors on date(s) listed below.

Assignee will hold all rights for its own use and benefit and for the use and benefit of its successors or assigns to the full end of the term for which the LETTERS PATENT may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignors if this assignment and sale had not been made. Assignors request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, US and its foreign counterparts, to issue the LETTERS PATENT when granted, in accordance with this assignment.

Assignors further agree that Assignors will, without demanding any further consideration therefor, at the request and expense of the Assignee, do all lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgment of instruments, that may be or become necessary for obtaining sustaining, extending, reissuing or reexamining United States and foreign LETTERS PATENT or the like for the invention, and for maintaining and perfecting the Assignee's right to the invention and LETTERS PATENT particularly in cases of interference conflict, opposition and litigation.

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




