For valuable consideration received or to be received, and hereby acknowledged, GERARDUS ANTONIUS SCHELLEKENS of Tondeloos 36, 5231 WB Den Bosch, the Netherlands, (hereinafter referred to as "Inventor"), hereby sells, assigns and transfers unto STICHTING VOOR DE TECHNISCHE WETENSCHAPPEN of Van Vollenhovenlaan 661, 3527 JP Utrecht, the Netherlands, its successors and assigns (hereinafter referred to as "Assignee") (it being understood that Assignee has obtained such ownership interest under Dutch law pursuant to an acquisition of rights held by the prior employer of Inventor, Nederlandse Organisatie voor wetenschappelijk Onderzoek), the entire interest for the United States of America, including all rights of priority under the international conventions and treaties, in and to a certain invention or improvement known as *Peptide Derived from an Antigen Recognized by Autoantibodies from Patients with Rheumatoid Arthritis, Antibody Directed Against Said Peptide, A Combinatorial Antigen and A Method of Detecting Auto-Immune Antibodies*, and described in an application filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on September 30, 1999, as Attorney Docket No. 30394-1027, and given U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 10/308,150, which claims priority of International Application Serial No. PCT/NL97/00624 filed November 14, 1997, for Dutch Patent Application Serial No. 1004539 filed November 15, 1996, and in all Letters Patent of the United States which may or shall be granted on said invention, or any parts thereof, or on said application, or on any provisional, utility, divisional, continuing, continuation-in-part, reissue, reexamination or other applications based in whole or in part thereon. And Inventor agrees hereafter to execute all applications, amended specifications, deeds or other instruments, and to do all acts necessary or proper in Assignee's sole discretion to secure to Assignee the grant of Letters Patent in the United States as Assignee may determine in its sole discretion, with specifications and claims in such form as shall be approved by

Assignee's counsel, and to vest and confirm in Assignee the legal and equitable title and full use and benefit of all such patents.

This assignment is limited solely to an assignment of rights for the United States of America, and is not to be used in any litigation, proceeding or legal action in any other country, including The Netherlands, or in the United States other than as to ownership of the subject Letters Patent.

Inventor hereby authorizes and requests the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, to issue such Letters Patent as shall be granted on said application or applications based thereon to Assignee.
