**ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, we, **Tamio Aihara, Bunichi Ohtsuki, and Kazuyuki Uenoyama** have invented certain improvements in a **Layered Scavenging Carburetor**, for which we are about to make application for Letters Patent of the United States of America; and

We further authorize said companies to apply for foreign patents on said inventions as agreed to by the Assignees hereof in their own names or through their

designees, including subsidiaries, related companies or assignees, under the International Convention or otherwise, and we further agree to execute all papers, including those required for the United States and foreign applications, and to perform such other proper acts as said companies may deem necessary to secure to said companies or its designees the rights herein assigned.
