PATENT ASSIGNMENT INSTRUMENT

This Patent Assignment Instrument ("Assignment") is dated July 31, 2007, and is made by INTERNETSEER.COM CORP., a Delaware corporation ("Assignor"), in favor of INTERNETSEER.COM, INC., a Virginia corporation ("Assignee").

Assignee and Assignor are parties to an Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of July 31, 2007 (the "Agreement"), pursuant to which Assignor has agreed to sell to Assignee and Assignee has agreed to buy from Assignor the Acquired Assets (as defined in the Agreement), including without limitation the patents and patent applications of Assignor used in the Business (as defined in the Agreement). Pursuant to the Agreement, Assignor has agreed to execute such instruments as Assignee may reasonably request in order to more effectively assign, transfer, grant, convey, assure and confirm to Assignee and its successors and assigns, or to aid and assist in the collection of or reducing to possession by Assignee of, all of such Acquired Assets.

Accordingly, in accordance with the foregoing and the terms of the Agreement, Assignor desires to transfer and assign to Assignee all of Assignor's worldwide right, title and interest in, to and under Assignor's domestic and foreign patents and patent applications used in the Business, including without limitation the patents listed on Schedule A of this Assignment, and all reissues, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, renewals and extensions thereof (all of the foregoing are collectively the "Patents").

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the payment of the purchase price set forth in the Agreement, and other good and valuable consideration, receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby transfers, conveys, sets over and assigns to Assignee all of Assignor's worldwide right, title and interest in, to and under the Patents, and all goodwill associated therewith, all rights to sue for infringement of any Patent, whether arising prior to or subsequent to the date of this Assignment, the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee, its successors and assigns from and after the date hereof as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this Assignment not been made.

Except to the extent that federal law preempts state law with respect to the matters covered hereby, this Assignment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia without giving effect to its principles of conflicts of laws.
