In consideration of my employment by Mark IV Industries Inc., or by any of its subsidiaries or affiliates (any and all hereinafter referred to as "MARK IV") and the compensation paid for my services, I will fully and promptly disclose and assign to MARK IV without additional compensation, all works of authorship, ideas, discoveries, inventions, and improvements, patentable or not, which, while I am so employed by MARK IV are made, suggested, conceived, or reduced to practice by me, alone or with others, during or after usual working hours, either on or off my job, and which are related to any product, process, method or machine connected in any way with the business of MARK IV. Any such works of authorship, ideas, discoveries, inventions or improvements which I shall record or otherwise report to another within eighteen (18) months after the date of termination of my employment with MARK IV shall be presumed to have been conceived prior to such termination date and shall be assigned to Mark IV, unless I am able to prove that they were conceived subsequent to my employment with MARK IV.

I agree, at MARK IV's expense, at any time during or after employment, to execute and deliver all papers, records, and data and do such other acts reasonably required of me to protect MARK IV's rights to said works of authorship, ideas, discoveries, inventions and improvements, including applying for, obtaining, and enforcing patents on said discoveries, inventions, and improvements in any and all countries.

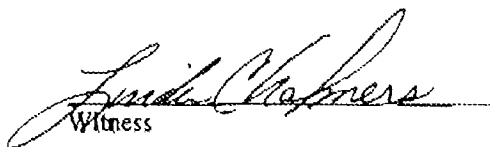
Except as listed below, I will not assert any rights under any inventions as having been made, acquired, or conceived by me prior to my employment by MARK IV.

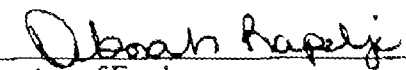
