

I, John Joseph Whitten, of St. John's, Newfoundland & Labrador, make oath and say that:

1. I was, immediately prior to its winding up, the President of Arctic Systems Ltd. ("Arctic"), and, as such, have personal knowledge of the matters herein declared unless stated to be based upon knowledge and belief.

2. In 1996, Arctic sold to Inland Technologies Inc. ("Inland") *inter alia* the rights to certain technology and related property in respect of glycol concentrators (collectively, the "Property"), by agreement pursuant to which a portion of the purchase price was due after closing. To secure payment in full of the purchase price, Inland issued to Arctic a security agreement dated as of September 23, 1996 (the "Security Agreement") under which Inland *inter alia* mortgaged and charged to Arctic, and granted to Arctic a security interest in, the Property and the Patents.

3. Arctic was wound up, and ceased to exist, on or about November 30, 2006.

4. Prior to the winding up of Arctic, Inland paid all amounts due to Arctic and fulfilled all of its obligations to Arctic, such that there remained no obligations for the Security Agreement to

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
secure and such that Arctic would have executed a release and discharge of the Security Agreement had this been requested by Inland.
