

This assignment is retroactively effective as of August 3, 2000.

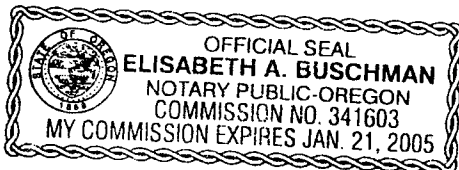
