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## PATENT DEED OF ASSIGNMENT

**"2007 AGREEMENT"** means that certain Assignment Agreement between INSTITUTION and RCT dated April 27, 2007.

**"INVENTORS"** means any of Dr. Joel Weiner, Dr. Raymond Turner, Mr. Glen Zhang (named as GUIJIN ZHANG on YebF patent application) and any other person identified as an inventor of any of the PATENT RIGHTS.

**"INVENTIONS"** means the inventions made by one or more INVENTORS pertaining to protein expression and presentation from *YebF* or pertaining to *membrane targeting translocation (mtt)* and comprising the inventions that are the subject of the PATENT RIGHTS.

**"INSTITUTION"** means The Governors of the University of Alberta, with offices at Edmonton, Alberta, Canada T6G 2E1.

### 1. BACKGROUND.

1.1. The INVENTORS made the INVENTIONS described in the PATENT RIGHTS and assigned their entire right, title and interest in the INVENTIONS and the PATENT RIGHTS to INSTITUTION.

1.2. Pursuant to the 2007 AGREEMENT, INSTITUTION assigned its entire right, title and interest in and to the INVENTIONS and the PATENT RIGHTS to RCT.

1.3. The 2007 AGREEMENT is being terminated, and INSTITUTION now desires that the INVENTIONS and the PATENT RIGHTS be assigned by RCT back to INSTITUTION. RCT has agreed to make such assignment on the following terms and conditions:

### 2. ASSIGNMENT

2.1. RCT hereby assigns to INSTITUTION RCT's entire right, title and interest in:

- (a) the INVENTIONS;
- (b) the PATENT RIGHTS and all foreign, divisional and continuation, in whole or in part, applications based on the PATENT RIGHTS;
- (c) all patents resulting from the applications described in the PATENT RIGHTS and otherwise described in (b) above; and

(d) all reissues, extensions, renewals and reexaminations of the patents described in the PATENT RIGHTS and otherwise described in (c) above.

2.2 This assignment will allow INSTITUTION to file the applications described in Paragraph 2.1 in its own name (but naming the INVENTORS as the inventors) in all countries of the world (where it is permissible) and the right to claim the benefit of the priority right provided by the International Convention of 1883, as amended.

2.3. RCT hereby authorizes and requests the United States Patent Office and other national or regional patent offices throughout the world to issue to INSTITUTION all patents described in Paragraph 2.1 that may be issued or granted.

2.4. RCT agrees to execute any further lawful documents that INSTITUTION deems reasonably necessary to fully protect INSTITUTION's interest in the INVENTIONS, the PATENT RIGHTS and the other items described in Paragraph 2.1.

2.5. RCT represents that it has not granted to anyone any right or license to use or practice under the PATENT RIGHTS except under this Assignment.

2.6. RCT represents that its right, title and interest in and to the PATENT RIGHTS have not been encumbered in any way, except by this Assignment, and that no document that conflicts with this Assignment has been or will be signed by RCT.
