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**U.S. PATENTS RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST**

THIS PATENT RELEASE dated as of November 15, 2007, between WASHINGTON GROUP INTERNATIONAL, INC., a Delaware corporation, as successor in interest to the registrant listed on Schedule I hereto (the "**Borrower**") and CREDIT SUISSE (formerly known as Credit Suisse First Boston) ("**Credit Suisse**"), as administrative agent (in such capacity, the "**Administrative Agent**"). Terms used herein and not otherwise defined shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Credit Agreement referred to below.

A. Reference is made to (i) the Second Amended and Restated Credit Agreement, dated as of June 14, 2005 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time prior to the date hereof, the "**Credit Agreement**"), among the Borrower, the lenders and issuers from time to time party thereto (the "**Lenders**") and the Administrative Agent, (ii) the Pledge and Security Agreement, dated as of January 24, 2002 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time prior to the date hereof, the "**Security Agreement**") and any other outstanding instruments entered into prior to the date hereof, among the Grantors (as defined in the Security Agreement) in favor of the Administrative Agent, for the benefit of certain secured parties named therein, in, among other things, the registered patents and pending patent applications of the Borrower set forth on Schedule I hereto (the "**Patents**"), which security interest was recorded with the United States Patent & Trademark Office and (iii) the Termination and Release Agreement dated as of November 15, 2007 (the "**Termination Agreement**"), among the Borrower, and the Administrative Agent.

B. In connection with the termination of the Credit Agreement, the Borrower has informed the Administrative Agent of their desire to obtain the release of all right, title and interest of the Administrative Agent, the Lenders and each other guarantee or beneficiary in and to the Patents granted under the Security Agreement.


C. Accordingly, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, all the Administrative Agent's right, title and interest (including, without limitation, security interests) in and to the Patents pursuant to the Security Agreement shall automatically terminate as provided in the Security Agreement (including without limitation, the Patents set forth on Schedule I hereto) and are hereby reassigned to the Borrower.
