PATENT ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Terry F. Jones, an individual residing at 7309 Wayside Road, Christiana, Tennessee, 37037, and Charles M. Leonard, an individual residing at 2118 Stillwell Court, Murfreesboro, Tennessee, 37130 (together, "Assignors" and each individually an "Assignor"), are joint-owners of the United States Letters Patent No. 6,602,598, issued August 5, 2003, entitled "Quiet Unwind Stretch Wrap Film" and the United States Letters Patent No. 6,265,055, issued July 24, 2001, entitled "Multilayer Stretch Cling Film" (together, the "Patents" and each individually a "Patent"), and any and all of the right, title and interest in and to any and all United States and foreign Letters Patents that may be granted in respect of any and all inventions covered by either of the Patents, and all divisions, continuations, renewals, reissues, and extensions thereof, and the applications therefor, and the right to claim the priority of such Letters Patents in any and all foreign countries where application for patent on said inventions may be filed (collectively, "Patent Rights");

WHEREAS, Manuli Stretch USA, Inc., a Delaware corporation (hereinafter "Assignee"), is desirous of acquiring each Assignor's entire right, title and interest in and to said Patents and Patent Rights; and

WHEREAS, in order to induce Assignors to assign their entire right, title and interest in and to said Patents and Patent Rights, Assignee has agreed to (i) pay each of the Assignors the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10) and (ii) assume certain liabilities of Quintec Films Corporation, the current licensee of the Patents, as set forth in that certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of November 15, 2007, by and among Assignors, Assignee and Quintec Films Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, for Ten Dollars (\$10) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, each Assignor does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto Assignee his entire right, title and interest in and to the Patents and Patent Rights together with the right to seek and/or obtain any recovery, whether in monetary or injunctive or in any other form whatsoever, from any individual or entity for past, present and future infringements or other violations of the Patents and/or Patent Rights. This assignment expressly grants Assignee all rights in the Patents and Patent Rights as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignors.





SPOUSAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND CONSENT

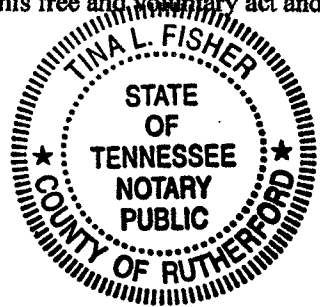
