I hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all Letters Patent of the United States for said invention, resulting from any of the aforesaid applications, to said ASSIGNEE.

This Assignment shall be binding upon my heirs, assigns, successors in interest and personal representatives and shall be

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specifically enforceable.

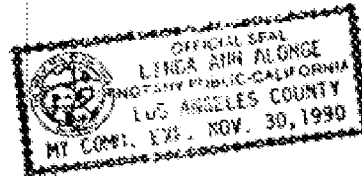
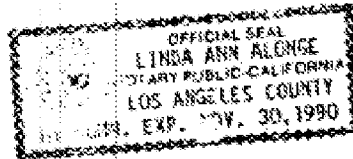
