WHEREAS, CARINA SYRING (hereinafter referred to as "assignor" and jointly as "assignors") depose and say that I am a citizen of Germany and an individual residing at Lindenhofstr. 28, CH-4052 Basel, Switzerland have invented certain new and useful improvements in an engineered osteochondral construct for treatment of articular cartilage defects for which I have filed an application for United States Letters Patent Application Number 60/544,355 filed February 17, 2004; entitled ENGINEERED OSTEOCHONDRAL CONSTRUCT FOR TREATMENT OF ARTICULAR CARTILAGE DEFECTS; and
