I, Andrew A. Abeyta, declare as follows:

1. Honeywell International Inc. ("Honeywell") is the correct owner of U.S. Patent No. 5,339,092, as evidenced by the following summary of the true chain of title.

a. U.S. Patent No. 5,339,092 is a continuation of abandoned U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 07/823,578, which was filed Jan. 16, 1992, and which is a continuation application of abandoned Application Serial No. 07/432,105, which was filed Nov. 6, 1989;

b. An executed assignment of the invention of Application Serial No. 07/432,105 was timely submitted to the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office, and recorded at Reel/Frame 005171/0933;

c. The subject matter of the executed and duly recorded assignment for Application Serial No. 07/432,105 encompasses any formal application that may be filed based on this application, which includes U.S. Patent No. 5,339,092.

d. A copy of the executed assignment and Abstract of Title from the USPTO is appended hereto as Appendix A.

2. The Security Interest recorded at Reel/Frame 007558/0568 was submitted with erroneous information, as delineated below:

- a. In the copy of the Security Interest appended hereto as Appendix B, several application numbers are referenced without the two-number prefix (e.g., 07/, 08/, D/, 29/, etc.);
- b. It appears as though the prefix "07/" was arbitrarily selected by the USPTO Assignment Division for the application number delineated as "005851";
- c. From the title and filing date associated with application number "005851" listed in the Security Interest, it is clear that "07/" is the incorrect prefix;
- d. The application that is correctly subject to the Security Interest is a design patent application filed on March 11, 1993 and entitled "Printer," and which was assigned Application Serial No. 5,851 by the USPTO (this patent has since issued as design patent no. D360,648, and is appended hereto as Appendix C).




