PATENT ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned:

Antoine ANDREMONT, a citizen of France, residing at 4 Villa Rose, 92240 Malakoff, France, and **Hélène-Céline HUGUET**, a citizen of France, residing at 106 Boulevard Jourdan, 75014 Paris, France, (hereinafter referred to as "Assignors") have invented certain inventions and improvements disclosed in a non-provisional application for Patent entitled Colonic Delivery of Metallo-Dependent Enzymes, which application was filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on November 15, 2007, under Application Serial No.: 11/985,411.

For the same consideration, Assignors by these presence do sell, assign and transfer to Da Volterra the full, exclusive and entire right, title and interest in and to any and all applications for industrial property protection, including without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, inventors' certificates and designs, (the "Foreign Applications") filed or which are

hereafter filed in countries foreign to the United States and describing in whole or in part the said inventions and improvements, in an to any Patents and similar protective rights granted on said Foreign Applications, and in and to the right to file such applications and the right to claim any applicable priority rights arising from or required for said Foreign Applications under the terms of any applicable conventions, treaties, statutes, or regulations; said Foreign Applications to be filed and issued in the name of Da Volterra or its respective designees, insofar as permitted by applicable law;

AND, for the same consideration, Assignors agree to communicate to the said Da Volterra, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to Assignors respecting said invention, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue and other applications, make all assignments and rightful oaths, and generally do everything possible to aid Da Volterra its successors, assigns, and nominees, to obtain and enforce proper protection for all said inventions and improvements in all countries throughout the world.
