

BILL OF SALE

THIS BILL OF SALE, made, executed and delivered as of this 5th day of February, 2008, by and between Marantech Holding LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Marantech"), and Aidance Skincare and Topical Solutions LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Aidance").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Marantech and Aidance are parties to a Technology Purchase and Cross-Licensing Agreement of even date herewith (the "Technology Transfer Agreement"), providing for, among other things, the transfer and sale to Aidance of the intellectual property of Marantech to the extent primarily relating to "Skincare or Topical Applications" (defined below), and the cross-licensing to each other of both the technology formerly owned by Marantech and that remaining with Marantech, depending upon its applicability to Skincare or Topical Applications or to other applications; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to summarize, in this Bill of Sale, the final disposition of such assets, so that third parties readily may rely upon this in ascertaining the ownership and/or licensed rights thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and of other valuable consideration paid to each party, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties do hereby certify and acknowledge the following:

1. Transfer and Licenses from Marantech to Aidance. Marantech hereby confirms and acknowledges that (a) it has sold, transferred and assigned, for full and adequate consideration, its intellectual property to the extent relating primarily to Skincare or Topical Applications, including without limitation those patents and patent applications set forth on Schedule I hereto, and that (b) it has irrevocably granted a perpetual, royalty-free, exclusive, fully transferable, worldwide license, including the right to freely sublicense, sub-sublicense and assign, and to use without restriction, those intellectual property assets to which it retains title, including without limitation those set forth on Schedule II hereto, to the extent that they are or may be useful in Skincare or Topical Applications.

2. License Back from Aidance to Marantech. Aidance hereby confirms and acknowledges that it has irrevocably granted a perpetual, royalty-free, exclusive, fully transferable, worldwide license, including the right to freely sublicense, sub-sublicense and assign, and to use without restriction, those intellectual property assets which are referred to in clause (a) hereof, for any business other than Skincare or Topical Applications.

3. Definition of "Skincare or Topical Applications". As used herein, the term "Skincare or Topical Applications" shall mean an application that makes contact with the body surfaces of humans or animals and provides either preventative or curative benefits. As used in the previous sentence, "body surfaces" shall include skin, fingernails, toenails, hair, eye surfaces, vaginal surfaces, tongue, teeth, gums, palate and ears, and similar body surfaces, of humans or animals. "Preventative" applications shall include, among other things, topical-contact textiles, devices,

lotions, pastes, cleansers, skin sanitizers, and any other topical-contact product with health maintenance and/or preventative benefits. "Curative" applications shall include, among other things, gels, creams, ointments, salves, lotions, pastes, devices, bandages, dressings, and an other topical-contact product with curative benefits.


4. Further Actions. The parties each hereby covenant and agree that, from time to time after the delivery of this instrument, at the other party's request and without further consideration, each party will do, execute, acknowledge and deliver or will cause to be done, executed, acknowledged and delivered, all and every such further acts, deeds, conveyances, transfers, assignments, powers of attorney and assurances as reasonably may be required more effectively to convey, transfer to and vest in such party, and put such party in possession of, the assets and license rights described above; and, in the case of any assets or license rights which cannot be effectively transferred or licensed without the consent of third parties, to endeavor to obtain such consents promptly and if any be unobtainable, to use its best efforts to assure the other party the benefits thereof.

5. Warranty Covenants. Marantech hereby covenants with Aidance that it is the lawful owner of the assets described in Paragraph 1(a) above; that such assets are being transferred free from all encumbrances, that Marantech has good right to sell the same as aforesaid; and that Marantech will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims demands of all persons.



This instrument is executed by, and shall be binding upon, Marantech and Aidance, their successors and assigns, for the uses and purposes above set forth and referred to, effective immediately upon its mutual execution and delivery. It may not be amended except in writing signed by duly authorized officers of both parties, nor may a provision hereof be waived except by a written instrument signed by the waiving party. Either party may show this instrument to third parties to demonstrate their ownership of the assets and/or license rights described herein.
