


Assignors request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, US and its foreign counterparts, to issue the **LETTERS PATENT** when granted, in accordance with this assignment.

Assignors further covenants and agree with the Assignee that Assignors have a full and unencumbered title to the invention, which title Assignors warrant to the Assignee. for the invention, and for maintaining and perfecting the Assignee's right to the invention and LETTERS PATENT particularly in cases of interference conflict, opposition and litigation.
