I. Appointment of Executor

On June 27, 2001, CONNIE SLOAN, (the "Decedent") died testate in the County of Alameda, State of California. At the time of her death, the Decedent was a resident of the County of Alameda and City of San Leandro. The Decedent's will dated March 20, 2000, was admitted by Order of this Court on November 20, 2001 and filed on November 20, 2001. On November 20, 2001, this Court appointed KIMBERLY BANKSTON-LEE as Administrator of the Estate. Letters Testamentary were issued on November 20, 2001. The Petitioner was granted full authority to act under the Independent Administration of Estates Act and said authority as to the Petitioner has not been revoked.

II. Notice of Death

After the Decedent's death, the Petitioner searched the Decedent's home and reviewed her mail to determine all known and reasonably ascertainable creditors. The Petitioner determined that there were known or reasonably ascertainable creditors described in Probate Code Section 9050. Notice to Creditors has been published for the period and in the manner prescribed by law. Within 30 days after the completion of publication of Notice to Creditors, there was filed with the Clerk of this Court an affidavit showing publication of Notice to Creditors in the manner and form required by law. More than four months have elapsed since the issuance of Letters of Administration in this Estate and since the first publication of Notice to Creditors. The time for filing or presenting claims has expired.

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III. Accounting Waived

7 **IX. Legal Advertising, Bond Premiums and Referee's Fees**

8 All legal advertising and fees of the probate referee have
9 been paid, and there are none outstanding. No bond was required.

11 **X. Request for Special Notice and Notice to Medi-Cal**

12 No request for Special Notice of these proceedings have been
13 made or filed herein.

14 The Petitioner knows of no public entity to which notice is
15 required under Probate Code Section 9201. No notice is required

18 spouse of a decedent who received Medi-Cal benefits. Although
19 Notice was not required, notice was sent to Department of Health
20 Services on March 1, 2002.

4 3% on \$85,791.82 = \$2,573.75

5 Total Compensation \$6,573.75

6 Petitioner requests that this Court authorize and allow
7 Petitioner to pay herself as administrator and pay her attorneys
8 each a total of \$6,573.75, as the statutory compensation to which

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XIV. Distribution of the Estate

5. Final distribution of the Estate of the Decedent shall be made as follows:


