ASSIGNMENT

Whereas, by virtue of an Assignment recorded in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on Reel 015656, Frame 0009, on February 7, 2005, KABUSHIKI KAISHA HAYASHIBARA SEIBUTSU KAGAKU KENKYUJO, a corporation having a place of business at 2-3, Shimoishii 1-Chome, Okayama-Shi, Okayama, Japan (hereinafter "HAYASHIBARA"), and KABUSHIKI KAISHA TOYOTA JIDOSHOKKI, a corporation having a place of business at 2-1, Toyoda-Cho, Kariya-Shi, Aichi, Japan (hereinafter "TOYOTA"), are the owners of the entire right, title and interest in and to United States Letters Patent issued to Makoto SATSUKI et al. for "ORGANIC ELECTROLUMINESCENT ELEMENT", which Letters Patent is numbered 7,338,720 and bears date March 4, 2008, and of the invention therein described; and

right to extend the protection of such Letters Patent to the various territorial possessions now owned or which may be hereafter acquired by the United States of America, all said rights to be held and enjoyed by TOYOTA for its own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns, or nominees to the full end of the term or terms for which said Letters Patent are granted, or may be reissued, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by HAYASHIBARA and TOYOTA jointly, if this assignment, transfer and sale had not been made; together with all claims for damages by reason of past infringement of said Letters Patent, with the right to sue for and collect the same for its own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns, or nominees.
