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Assignment

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR, by these presents, does sell, assign, convey and transfer unto said ASSIGNEE and its successors and assigns the full and exclusive right in and to said Inventions, Patent Rights, and Related Documents in the United States and its territorial possessions and in all foreign countries and the entire right, title and interest, including the right to sue for past infringement, if any, all income, royalties, damages, claims and payments now or hereafter due or payable, and all rights pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §154, in and to any and all Letters Patent which may be granted therefor in the United States and its territorial possession and in any and all foreign countries, including all rights of priority under any international conventions and any other international agreements to which the United States adheres, and in and to any and all divisions, continuations, substitutions, renewals, re-examination, extension and reissues thereof, and any other applications claiming priority thereto;

ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes and requests any Patent Office official in the United States and its territorial possessions and in any and all foreign countries to issue any and all of said Letters Patent, when granted, to said ASSIGNEE as the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the same, for the sole use and benefit of ASSIGNEE and ASSIGNEE's successors and assigns, to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by ASSIGNOR had this assignment and sale not been made.

ASSIGNOR agrees to execute such additional documents, complete such other formalities, and extend such other cooperation as may be reasonably requested or required to perfect ASSIGNEE'S interest in the Patent Rights and Inventions assigned hereunder, and to permit ASSIGNEE to be duly recorded as the registered owner and proprietor of the rights

hereby conveyed, including, without limitation, any appropriate instruments required to be filed in the applicable national trademark, copyright or patent offices or other appropriate offices. In the event ASSIGNEE is unable, after reasonable effort, to secure ASSIGNOR'S signature on any letters patent, copyright or other analogous protection relating to such Patent Rights or Inventions assigned hereunder, for any reason whatsoever, ASSIGNOR hereby irrevocably designates and appoints ASSIGNEE and its duly authorized officers and agents as ASSIGNOR'S agent and attorney-in-fact, which appointment is coupled with an interest, to act for and in its behalf and stead to execute and file any such application or applications and to do all other lawfully permitted acts to further the prosecution and issuance of letters patent, copyright or other analogous protection thereon with the same legal force and effect as if executed by ASSIGNOR. This Confirmatory Assignment shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of each of the parties hereto, their successors and permitted assigns.
