ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Relume is desirous of obtaining from Cuetronics the entire right, title and interest in and to the Application.



Cuetronics hereby authorizes the Director of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office to issue to Relume all Letters Patent of the United States that may hereafter issue from the Application, for the sole and exclusive use of Relume and Relume's legal representatives.

By this Assignment Cuetronics assigns, transfers and sets over to Relume all rights to sue for past infringements of U.S. Patent No. 5,661,645, and retains no rights whatsoever to recover for any infringements of said patent or to sue in Cuetronics own name in regard to said patent, the grant of rights under this Assignment covering all patent rights as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Cuetronics had this Assignment not been made.
