ASSIGNMENT

THIS ASSIGNMENT ("Assignment") is effective as of the 12th day of February 2008, among TIGERONE DEVELOPMENT, LLC, a Washington limited liability company ("Assignor") and TAC UNIT, LLC, a Washington limited liability company ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, the Assignor is the owner of certain new and useful improvements.

WHEREAS, the Assignee desires to acquire all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the invention from the Assignor, and the Assignor is interested in transferring the Patents to the Assignee.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration of a fifty percent (50%) membership interest in Assignee, and other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Assignor and Assignee agree as follows:

1. Assignment of Invention. Assignor hereby assigns and transfers to Assignee the invention, including, without limitation, all rights, title and interest:

(a) in and to an invention entitled "COOLING AND HEATING SYSTEMS AND METHODS UTILIZING THERMO-ELECTRIC DEVICES" for which U.S. Patent Application 11/242, 189 was filed on October 15, 2005;

(b) in and to all other applications for Letters Patent (including divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part and reissue applications) based upon said invention, including continuation application serial number 12/014, 786 filed January 16, 2008, and in and to the patent or patents to be granted thereon, including reissues thereof, if any, to the full extent of the term or terms for which said patent or patents may be granted;

(c) in and to all applications for patents on said invention now or hereafter filed in countries foreign to the United States of America, and in and to any and all patents granted on said applications to the full end of the terms for which said patents may be granted; and

(d) under the International Convention in respect to the United States patent application and agree than any applications for Letters Patent of any foreign countries which may be filed shall be filed in the name of Assignee with a claim to priority based on said United States application.

2. Assumption. Assignee hereby acknowledges and agrees to all of the terms of the patent application and accepts the foregoing assignment and assumes and agrees to perform all obligations of Assignor, if any, under the patent application, in accordance with the terms thereof. Assignee shall indemnify, defend and hold Assignor harmless from and against any and all costs and liabilities (including attorneys fees) arising out of or relating to the patent application.

3. Consideration. In exchange for Assignor's assignment of all rights and interest in and to the Patent, Assignee hereby grants to Assignor the following described membership interests in Assignee:

5. Legal Fees. The parties hereto acknowledge and agree that Assignee, its successors or assigns, will pay any and all expense incident to the assignment of the Patent to Assignee.

6. Governing Law. This Assignment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.

7. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in counterparts and delivered via facsimile, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all counterparts together shall be construed as one and the same.

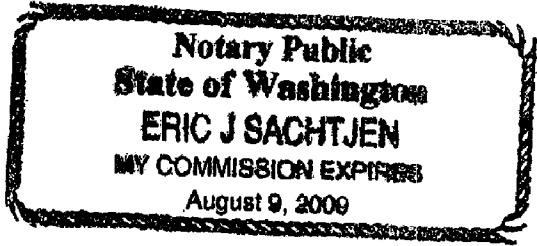
