

any of the Rights in the name of the Assignee, as the assignee to the entire interest therein.

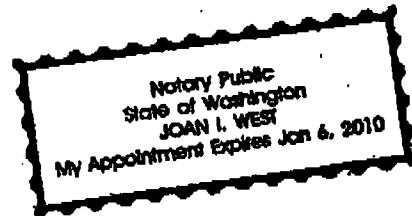


