ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Charles C. Frost and Jonathan M. Rathbun, residing at 5760 Grand River Drive, Ada, Michigan 49301, and 2001 Meek Drive N.E., Belmont, Michigan 49306, respectively (hereinafter referred to as Assignors), have invented certain new and useful improvements in a MEASURING DEVICE FOR CONVEYOR CHAIN for which a United States provisional application was filed on November 23, 2005 and assigned Serial No. 60/739,588, and for which an application for United States Letters Patent was filed on November 21, 2006 and assigned Serial No. 11/602,790.






