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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Kenneth LARGMAN, a resident of San Francisco, County of San Francisco, State of California; Anthony B. MORE, a resident of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California; and Jeffrey BLAIR, a resident of San Francisco, County of San Francisco, State of California, (hereinafter termed "Inventors") have invented certain new and useful improvements in EXTERNAL REPAIR OF A COMPUTER and have executed an application for a United States patent disclosing and identifying the invention and having Serial No. 10/074,686 and filing date of February 11, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Self Repairing Computers, Inc. (hereinafter termed "Assignee"), a corporation of the State of California, having a place of business at 2460 21st Avenue, San Francisco, California 94116, State of California, is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to the application and the invention disclosed therein, and in and to all embodiments of the invention, heretofore conceived, made or discovered by the Inventors (all collectively hereinafter termed "the invention"), and in and to any and all patents, inventor's certificates and other forms of protection (hereinafter termed "patents") thereon granted in the United States and foreign countries.

The Inventors do hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey unto the Assignee, the entire right, title and interest (a) in and to the application and the invention; (b) in and to all rights to apply for foreign patents on the invention pursuant to the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property or otherwise; (c) in and to any and all applications filed and any and all patents granted on the invention in the United States or any foreign country, including each and every application filed and each and every patent granted on any application which is a division, substitution, or continuation of any of the applications; and (d) in and to each and every reissue or extension of any of the patents.

2. The Inventors hereby covenant and agree to cooperate with the Assignee to enable the Assignee to enjoy to the fullest extent the right title and interest herein conveyed in the United States and foreign countries. Such cooperation by the Inventors shall include prompt production of pertinent facts and documents, giving of testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, specifications, declarations or other papers, and other assistance all to the extent deemed necessary or desirable by the Assignee (a) for perfecting in the Assignee the right, title and interest herein conveyed; (b) for prosecuting any of the applications; (c) for filing and prosecuting substitute, divisional, continuing or additional applications covering the invention; (d) for filing and prosecuting applications for reissuance of any of the patents; (e) for interference or other priority

proceedings involving the invention; and (f) for legal proceedings involving the invention and any applications therefor and any patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by the Inventors in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by the Assignee.

3. The terms, covenants and conditions of this assignment shall inure to the benefit of the Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon the Inventors, their heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

4. The Inventors hereby warrant and represent that they have not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.
