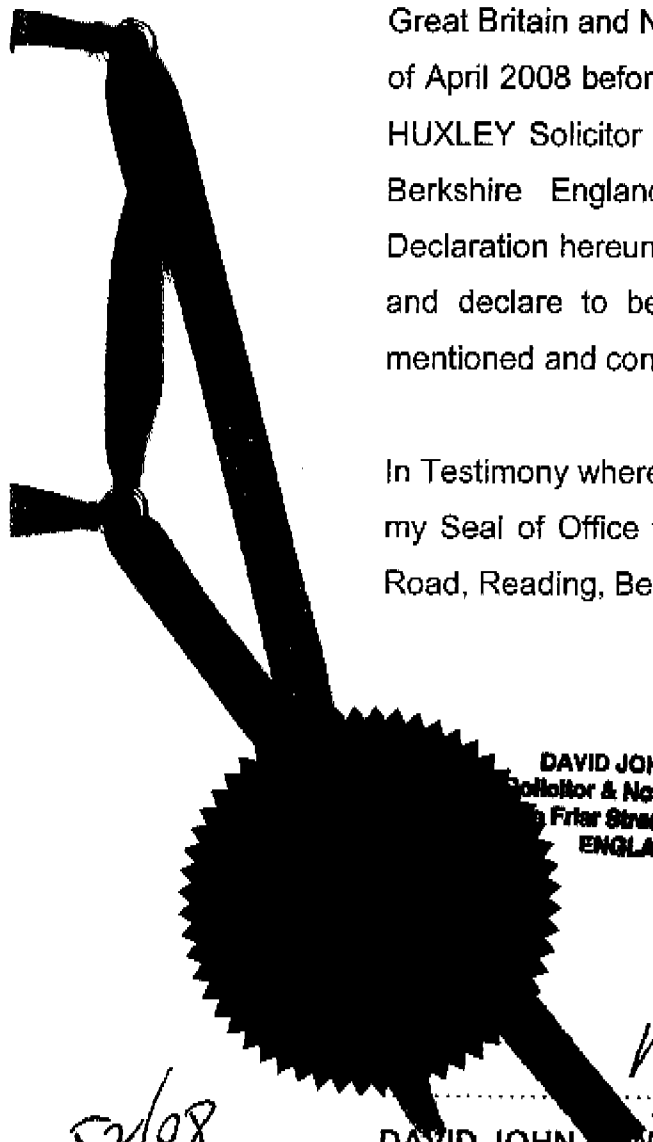

2 FURTHER ASSURANCE

2.1 At the request of the Buyer, the Seller shall provide all reasonable assistance which the Buyer considers necessary in connection with:

2.1.1 Bringing or defending any proceedings relating to any of the rights assigned by this assignment;

2.1.2 Obtaining the grant of a patent pursuant to any application assigned by this assignment; or

2.1.3 Otherwise giving to the Buyer the full benefit of all the provisions of this Assignment, Provided that the expense of providing such assistance shall be borne by the Buyer together with any VAT chargeable thereon.

3 WARRANTIES

The Buyer acknowledges that no warranty is given or intended to be given by the Seller as to the truth of the facts and matters set out in the Recitals to this Assignment or otherwise.



4 LAW AND JURISDICTION
