PATENT AND INVENTION ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned:

- (A) **Jean-Christophe EHRSTROM**, a citizen of France, residing at 5 Place des Jacobins, 38103 Echirolles, France;
- (B) **Laurent CERVI**, a citizen of France, residing at Résidence Par.Bât.C, Lieu-dit Les Noisetiers, 38430 Moirans, France;
- (C) **Frank EBERL**, a citizen of France, residing at Bât.B-16 rue Fétola, 38120 Fontanil Cornillon, France; and
- (D) **Michelle SALVIA**, a citizen of France, residing at 51 Chemin de Grandvaux, 69120 Ecully, France.

(hereinafter collectively referred to as "Assignors) have invented certain inventions and improvements disclosed in a provisional application for United States patent entitled **STRUCTURAL ELEMENT MADE OF AN ALUMINUM ALLOY INCLUDING AN OPTICAL SENSOR**, which application was filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on March 18, 2008 and assigned Application. No. 12/050,888;

the said inventions and improvements, preparatory to obtaining Patents of the United States therefore, (iv) in and to all patents of the United States which may be granted on the foregoing and all reissues and extensions thereof and (v) in and to the right to claim any applicable foreign and domestic priority rights arising from any of the afore-mentioned patent applications; and Assignors hereby request the Commissioner of Patents to issue any and all Patents of the United States resulting from such non-provisional patent applications, or from a division, continuation, continuation-in-part, or reissue thereof, to Assignee, for the interest and for the sole use and behoof of Assignee and its assigns and legal representatives ; and

Assignors by these presents do sell, assign and transfer to **Assignee** the full, exclusive and entire right, title and interest: in and to any and all applications for industrial property protection, including without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, inventors' certificates and designs, (the "Foreign Applications") filed or which are hereafter filed in countries foreign to the United States and describing in whole or in part the said inventions and improvements, in and to any Patents and similar protective rights granted on said Foreign Applications, and in and to the right to file such applications; and

Assignors agree that said **Assignee** may apply for and receive foreign Letters Patents or rights of any other kind for said inventions, or any of them; and may claim, in applications for said foreign Letters Patent or other rights, the priority of the aforesaid United States patent applications under the provisions of the International Convention of 1883 and later modifications thereof, under the Patent Cooperation Treaty, under the European Patent Convention or under any other available international agreement; and that, when requested, without charge to, but at the expense of, said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, to carry out in good faith the intent and purpose of this assignment, the undersigned or the undersigned's executors or administrators will, for the United States and all foreign countries, execute all divisional, continuing, substitute, renewal, reissue, and all other patent applications or other documents on any and all said inventions; execute all rightful oaths, assignments, powers of attorney and other papers; communicate to said Assignee, its successors, assigns and representatives, all facts known and documents available to the undersigned relating to said inventions and the history thereof; testify in all legal proceedings; and generally do everything


possible which said Assignee, its successors, assigns or representatives shall consider desirable for aiding in securing, maintaining and enforcing proper patent protection for said inventions and for vesting title to said inventions and all applications for patents or related foreign rights and all patents on said inventions, in said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives; and

Assignors covenant with Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives that no assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other agreement affecting the rights and property herein conveyed has been made to others by the undersigned.


