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PATENT ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, MEADWESTVACO CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor"), owns all right, title and interest in and to the patents and patent applications identified in Schedule A attached hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "Patent Intellectual Property"); and

WHEREAS, KAPSTONE CHARLESTON KRAFT LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (hereinafter referred to as "Assignee"), is desirous of acquiring the entire domestic and foreign right, title and interest in and under the Patent Intellectual Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor assigns and transfers to the Assignee and the Assignee's legal representatives, successors and assigns, pursuant to the terms of that certain Asset Purchase Agreement among Assignor, Assignee and the other parties thereto dated as of July 1, 2008 (the "Asset Purchase Agreement"), its entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent Intellectual Property and to any applications which claim priority to such Patent Intellectual Property and any applications directed to any invention disclosed in the Patent Intellectual Property that may be filed in the United States or any foreign country, and extensions or derivations thereof, that may issue thereon, and Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue U.S. patents for those U.S. patent applications identified in Schedule A, or to any continuation, continuation-in-part, or divisional applications thereof, to the above-mentioned Assignee agreeably with the terms of this assignment document. This assignment of rights includes all income, royalties, damages and payments now or hereafter due or payable with respect to the Patent Intellectual Property and all causes of action (either in law or in equity) related to such Patent Intellectual Property, including the right to recover damages for past, present or future infringement.

UPON SAID CONSIDERATION, Assignor conveys to the Assignee the right to make application in its own behalf for protection of the Patent Intellectual Property in the U.S. and countries foreign to the U.S. and to claim under the Patent Cooperation Treaty, the International Convention and/or other international arrangement for any such application the date of any earlier U.S. application or any foreign application on the invention which is part of the Patent Intellectual Property to gain priority with respect to other applications;

ASSIGNOR DOES HEREBY COVENANT and agree with the Assignee that Assignor will cooperate to effectuate the recordation of this transfer, that Assignor will not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with the terms of this assignment document set forth herein, and that Assignor will at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration, but at the expense of the Assignee, execute such additional assignments and other writings and do such additional acts as the Assignee may deem reasonably necessary or desirable to perfect the Assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render reasonable and necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, divisional, continuation, renewal, reissued, or extended Letters Patent of the United States or of any and all foreign countries on the Patent Intellectual

Property, and in enforcing any rights or choses in action accruing as a result of such applications or patents, and by executing statements and other affidavits, it being understood that the foregoing covenant and agreement shall bind, and inure to the benefit of, the assigns and legal representatives of both parties.

Assignor further covenants that Assignee will, upon its reasonable request and at the expense of the Assignee, be provided promptly with all pertinent facts and documents relating to the Patent Intellectual Property as may be known and accessible to Assignor and Assignor will testify as to the same in any interference or litigation related thereto and will promptly execute and deliver to Assignee or its legal representative any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain and enforce the Patent Intellectual Property which may be reasonably necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes hereof.

Assignor further covenants that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this Patent Assignment.

This assignment is made and accepted upon and subject to the provisions under the Asset Purchase Agreement. Nothing contained in this assignment shall be deemed to supersede, or modify any of the obligations, agreements, covenants or warranties of Seller, Parent or Purchaser contained in the Asset Purchase Agreement. If any conflict exists between the terms of this assignment and the Asset Purchase Agreement, then the terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement shall govern and control.



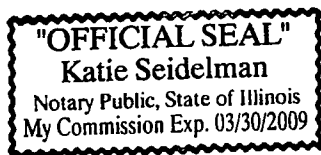
