CONFIRMATORY ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, PROFESSOR MINO GREEN of 55 Gerard Road, London SW13 9QH ("Professor Green") is listed as the inventor of U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 10/049,736 dated July 22, 2002, that application being the entry into the national phase of International Application PCT/GB00/03202 filed on 17 August 2000;

WHEREAS, Professor Green executed an assignment document on 8 July 2002 assigning his rights in the above-identified application to IMPERIAL COLLEGE OF SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND MEDICINE, a corporation of the country of the United Kingdom having a place of business at Exhibition Road, London SW7 2AZ United Kingdom ("The College"), that document having been recorded by the United States Patent and Trademark Office on 22 July 2002 at Reel 013419 beginning at Frame 0827;

WHEREAS, on 8 November 1999 Professor Green had assigned his rights in the above-identified International Application to IMPERIAL COLLEGE INNOVATIONS LTD. of 47 Princes Gate, London SW7 2QA ("ICI"), which until 27 April 2005, was a wholly owned subsidiary technology transfer company of The College;

WHEREAS, all of Professor Green, The College and ICI now recognize that in order to affect a formal transfer of and to vest title to the above-identified patent application in ICI it is necessary to file with the United States Patent and Trademark Office for purposes of recording a confirmatory instrument specifically enumerating the patent application so assigned:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Professor Green does hereby acknowledge, confirm and certify that he sold, assigned and transferred and does hereby sell, assign and transfer onto the said ICI, a wholly owned subsidiary of The College, the entire right, title and interest in and to any and all Letters Patent which may be granted therefore in the United States and its territorial possessions and in and to any and all continuations-in-part, continuations, divisions, substitutes, reissues, extensions or reexaminations thereof and all other applications for Letters Patent relating thereto which have been filed or shall be filed in the United States and its territorial possessions, and all rights, together with all priority rights under any of the International Conventions, Unions, Agreements, Acts, Treaties, including all

future Conventions, Unions, Agreements, Acts and Treaties, the same to be held by ICI for its own use and behalf and for its successors and assigns to the full end of the term for which any patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by Professor Green had this assignment and sale not been made.
