Title : Seat System With Shock- And Vibration Reducing Bladders

WHEREAS, Board of Regents of the Nevada System of Higher Education, on behalf of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, a public agency of the State of Nevada, having offices at 4505 Maryland Parkway, Las Vegas, Nevada 89154-1085, ("Assignor") is the owner of right, title and interest in an invention for certain new and useful improvements as described in an application entitled Seat System With Shock- And Vibration Reducing Bladders for Letters Patent of the United States, the application being identifiable in the United States Patent and Trademark Office by Application No. 60/940,462, filed May 29, 2007 (the "invention"); and

Assignor authorizes the Assignee, its successors and assigns, or anyone it may properly designate, to apply for Letters Patent or similar legal protection, in its own name if desired, in any and all foreign countries.

Assignor represents to Assignee, its successors and assigns, that Assignor has not and shall not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with this Assignment. Assignor or its successors will at any time upon request, without additional consideration, but at the expense of the Assignee, its successors and assigns, execute such additional writings and do such additional acts as the Assignee, its successors and assigns, may deem desirable to perfect its enjoyment of this grant, and render all assistance in making application for and obtaining, maintaining, and enforcing the Letters Patent or similar legal protection on the invention in any and all countries.

Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, Assignor retains the right to use the invention for its own non-commercial, educational, teaching and research purposes without payment of royalties or other fees.

Assignor makes no representations and extends no warranties of any kind, either express or implied,

including, but not limited to, warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. Assignor does not warrant the invention will be patentable. Assignor does warrant that its research is scientifically accurate and performed in accordance with all applicable scientific principles and methodologies. Assignee does warrant that its research is scientifically accurate and performed in accordance with all applicable scientific principles and methodologies.

Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed as a warranty or representation that the invention will be free from infringement of patents or other intellectual property or proprietary rights of third parties.






