## PATENT SECURITY AGREEMENT

PATENT SECURITY AGREEMENT, dated as of August 8, 2008, by Creative Edge Design Group, Ltd., an Ohio limited liability company ("Grantor"), in favor of Packaging Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Lender").

### W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Loan and Security Agreement dated as of the date hereof by and among Grantor; Superior Dairy, Inc., an Ohio corporation, and LEL Operating Company, an Ohio corporation (collectively "Borrowers") and Lender's predecessor (including all annexes, exhibits or schedules thereto, as from time to time amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, the "Credit Agreement"), Lender has agreed to make certain Loans for the benefit of Borrowers;

WHEREAS, Lender is willing to make such Loans, but only upon the condition, among others, that Grantor execute and deliver to Lender this Patent Security Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Grantor hereby agrees as follows:

1. DEFINED TERMS. Unless otherwise noted, all capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein have the meanings given to them in the Credit Agreement.

2. GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENT COLLATERAL. To secure the Obligations, Grantor hereby grants to Lender a continuing first priority security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under the following, whether presently existing or hereafter created or acquired (collectively, the "Patent Collateral"):

- (a) all of the patents and patent applications listed on Schedule I hereto (the "Patents");
- (b) all reissues, continuations or extensions of the foregoing;
- (c) all licenses to third parties of any rights to use or otherwise enjoy the benefits of any of the Patents;
- (d) all goodwill of the business connected with the use of, and symbolized by, each Patent; and
- (e) all products and proceeds of the foregoing, including, without limitation, any rights under licenses of any Patent and any claim by Grantor against third parties for past, present or future (i) infringement of any Patent or (ii) injury to the goodwill associated with any Patent.


3. CREDIT AGREEMENT. The security interests granted pursuant to this Patent Security Agreement are granted in conjunction with the security interests granted to Lender pursuant to the Credit Agreement. Grantor hereby acknowledges and affirms that the

rights and remedies of Lender with respect to the security interest in the Patent Collateral made and granted hereby are more fully set forth in the Credit Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth herein.




