ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, THI N. PHAM, residing at 2316 NE 86th Street, Seattle, WA 98115; **TORD KURTHY**, residing at 953 Field Avenue NE, Renton, WA 98059; **DAVID R. GLADISH**, residing at 15312 SE 82nd, Newcastle, WA 98059; **JEFFREY M. KOMATSU**, residing at 2919 SE 4th Street, Renton, WA 98056; **MICHAEL A. PHAM**, residing at 425 Graham Avenue NE, Renton, WA 98059; and **EUGENE T. ROGERS**, residing at 11802 S.E. 66th Street, Bellevue, WA 98006; (hereinafter "Assignors") have invented certain new and useful improvements in **QUICK MOUNT RELAY APPARATUS AND METHOD OF INSTALLATION** (hereinafter "invention") for which Assignors are making or have made application for LETTERS PATENT OF THE UNITED STATES, which application has been duly executed by Assignors on date listed below.

Assignee will hold all rights for its own use and benefit and for the use and benefit of its successors or assigns to the full end of the term for which the LETTERS PATENT may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignors if this assignment and sale had not been made. Assignors request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, US and its foreign counterparts, to issue the LETTERS PATENT when granted, in accordance with this assignment.

Assignors further covenant and agree with the Assignee that Assignors have a full and unencumbered title to the invention, which title Assignors warrants to the Assignee. Assignors further agree that Assignors will, without demanding any further consideration therefor, at the request and expense of the Assignee, do all lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgment of instruments, that may be or become
