JOINT PLAN AND AGREEMENT OF MERGER

THIS AGREEMENT OF MERGER (the "Agreement") is made and entered into as of the 1st day of May, 1999 (the "Effective Date") by and between Behavioral Informatics, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation (sometimes referred to as the "Surviving Corporation"), and GEROTECH INC., a Pennsylvania corporation ("Gerotech").

WHEREAS, all of the shares of the Surviving Corporation and Gerotech which are presently issued and outstanding are owned by Anthony P. Glascock ("Glascock") and David M. Kutzik ("Kutzik"), and

WHEREAS, to achieve greater economies of management and personnel and to strengthen their overall financial and competitive positions, the respective Boards of Directors and shareholders of the Surviving Corporation and Gerotech deem it advisable that Gerotech be merged into the Surviving Corporation and cease its separate existence on the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement and in accordance with the applicable provisions of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which permit such a statutory merger.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter set forth, it is hereby agreed that the Surviving Corporation and Gerotech shall combine in a statutory merger within the meaning of Section 368(a)(1)(A) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, pursuant to the appropriate provisions of the Business Corporation Law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the parties hereto hereby do agree upon and prescribe the following terms and conditions for carrying the said merger into effect:

1. The Surviving Corporation and Gerotech are corporations duly organized, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
2. Gerotech shall be merged into the Surviving Corporation.
3. Upon effectiveness of the merger, the corporate existence of Gerotech thereupon shall cease, and the Surviving Corporation shall be the surviving corporation.
4. Upon consummation of the merger, the name of the Surviving Corporation shall continue to be Behavioral Informatics, Inc.
5. Upon consummation of the merger, the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws in effect for Behavioral Informatics, Inc. prior to the merger shall be the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws for the Surviving Corporation.
6. The directors of the Surviving Corporation shall be Anthony P. Glascock and David M. Kutzik. Such directors of the Surviving Corporation shall hold office until their successors are duly elected, qualified and have commenced serving.

7. The terms of the merger, the mode of carrying them into effect, and the manner and basis of converting the Gerotech common stock into shares of the Surviving Corporation shall be as follows:

(a) All of the shares of Gerotech common stock which are issued and outstanding on the Effective Date and all rights in respect thereto shall, by virtue of the merger and without any action on the part of Glascock or Kutzik, be converted forthwith into shares of common stock in Behavioral Informatics, Inc., such that Glascock and Kutzik each shall receive 49 shares of the Surviving Corporation for all of their shares of Gerotech.

(b) All shares of the common stock of Behavioral Informatics, Inc. into which the outstanding shares of Gerotech are thus converted shall be in full satisfaction of all rights pertaining to the shares of Gerotech and shall be validly issued and outstanding, fully paid and non-assessable.

(c) After the date on which the merger becomes effective, Glascock and Kutzik shall surrender the certificates representing shares of Gerotech to the Surviving Corporation, or any agent appointed by it, duly endorsed if and as the Surviving Corporation may require, and Glascock and Kutzik shall be entitled upon such surrender to receive in exchange therefor certificates representing 49 shares each of the common stock of the Surviving Corporation to which Glascock and Kutzik shall be entitled as a result of the merger.

8. Upon the merger becoming effective, all of the rights, privileges, immunities, powers, franchises and authority, of a public as well as of a private nature, and all property and assets of every kind and description, and every interest therein, of Gerotech, including, without limitation, patents, patent applications and any continuations and continuations-in-part thereof as well as any patents issuing therefrom and any foreign patent applications filed thereupon, trademarks, licenses and registrations, if any, shall be vested in and held and enjoyed by the Surviving Corporation without further act or deed, and all estates and interests of every kind of Gerotech shall be as effectually the property of the Surviving Corporation as they were of Gerotech. Upon the merger becoming effective, all rights of creditors and all liens upon any property of Gerotech shall be preserved unimpaired, and all debts, liabilities and duties of Gerotech shall thenceforth attach to the Surviving Corporation and may be enforced against it to the same extent as if said debts, liabilities and duties had been incurred or contracted by it.

9. This Agreement, as part of the Articles of Merger, shall be delivered for filing to the Department of State of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Business Corporation Law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the merger shall become effective as of the date of filing.
