patent that may issue from the Application or from any other patent applications directed to said invention, any other patents or like grants or protection on said Invention, and any trade secret misappropriation of said Invention;

4. The right to Assignee to file in its name applications for patents and like grants or protection for said Invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States; and

5. All international rights or priority associated with said Invention, said Application, and any other applications for patents, patents and like grants or protection on said Invention.
