(hereinafter "invention") for which Assignor is making or has made application for LETTERS PATENT OF



And Assignor does hereby request and authorize the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, U.S.A., to issue said U.S. LETTERS PATENT, when granted, in accordance with this assignment.
