Assignment of Invention Before Patent (herein "Assignment")

Section 1 Background

We, Laurence G. Hassebrook, Ph.D., Daniel L. Lau, Ph.D. and Chun Guan of Kentucky (herein "Inventors"), have invented or discovered a new and useful process, machine, manufacture, or composition of matter, or an improvement thereof, for which a provisional patent application (60/382,202) was filed 21-May-02 and for which a nonprovisional patent application is being filed concurrently with the U.S. Patent Office entitled: System and Technique for Retrieving Depth Information about a Surface by Projecting a Composite Image of Modulated Light Patterns.
