ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

On the date shown below, and for good and valuable consideration the receipt of which we acknowledge, we made the following assignment and promises to Swisher Mower & Machine Company, Inc., a Missouri corporation having a principal place of business at 1602 Corporate Drive, Warrensburg, Missouri 64093, in connection with our invention of a new, original Universal Front and Rear Equipment Mount for ATV (Invention”).

1. We assign, transfer, and convey to Assignee the entire right, title and interest in and to:
 - (a) the Invention;
 - (b) U.S. Provisional Application No. 60/901,776 filed February 16, 2007 for Universal Front and Rear Equipment Mount for ATV;
 - (c) U.S. Utility Patent Application No. 1205114 filed February 14, 2008 for Universal Front and Rear Equipment Mount for ATV;
 - (d) all provisional or utility patent applications which may be filed in the United States with respect to the Invention;
 - (e) all Letters Patent issued pursuant to, or as a result of, the applications referenced above;
 - (f) all applications for Letters Patent, or similar legal protection, which may be filed in any country or countries foreign to the United States with respect to the Invention;
 - (g) all Letters Patent which may be granted for the Invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States; and
 - (h) all extensions, renewals, reissues, divisions, and continuations (or their legal equivalents) of any applications or Letters Patent referred to above.

2. We authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States whose duty it is to issue patents or similar legal protection on applications, to issue to Assignee all Letters Patent or similar legal protection for the Invention or improvements.

3. We agree that, upon the request of Assignee, we will
 - (a) execute any and all utility, divisional and renewal applications for the Invention or improvements;




- (b) execute any supplemental oath relating to the Invention or improvements;
- (c) execute any application for reissue or extension of any Letters Patent that may be granted upon the application;
- (d) cooperate to the best of our ability in connection with any Interference proceeding, including but not limited to, cooperation in connection with preparing the preliminary statement and giving and producing evidence in support of such preliminary statement;
- (e) perform any and all affirmative acts to obtain Letters Patent and vest all right in such Letters Patent in Assignee; and
- (f) perform such additional acts as Assignee may deem necessary or expedient in connection with any of the matters stated above.





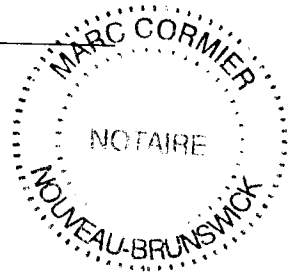
