I, Michel Dufour, declare that:


1. I am President of ALLIOS, which was formerly known as LES PEINTURES JEFECO FRANCIS AND JEAN DUFOUR.
2. This declaration is being submitted to correct an error recently discovered in the recorded assignment in the above-identified patent.
3. In a document dated June 23, 1998, the four inventors in the above-identified patent (Pierre Legrand, Gerald Riess, Jean-Philippe Lerch, and Daniel Lefevre) assigned all of their rights in the patent application that resulted into this patent over to LES PEINTURES JEFECO. The assignment document was recorded on July 24, 1998 under Reel 009726 and Frame 0758.
4. There is an error in this assignment. The true and complete name of the assignee is LES PEINTURES JEFECO FRANCIS AND JEAN DUFOUR. The last portion of the name of the

company, "FRANCIS AND JEAN DUFOUR", was inadvertently omitted from name of the assignee in the assignment document. The assignment should have properly listed the full name of the company, LES PEINTURES JEFECO FRANCIS AND JEAN DUFOUR.

5. At least two of the inventor assignors are not available to record a new assignment document or to correct the original assignment. Gerald Reiss was a professor who has since retired and Jean-Philippe Lerch is no longer with the company. Upon information and belief, neither inventor can be found.

6. All statements made herein of my own knowledge are true, and all statements made herein on information and belief are believed to be true. I am aware that willful false statements and the like are punishable by fine or imprisonment or both (18 U.S.C. 1001), and may jeopardize the validity of the above-referenced patent.
