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## ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS

**THIS ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS** (this “**Assignment**”) is made as of January 14, 2009 by and between Gold Tip, Inc., a Utah corporation (“**Assignor**”) and Gold Tip, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (“**Assignee**”).

### BACKGROUND

A. Assignor is the owner of the patents and patent applications listed on **Exhibit A** (the “**Patents and Patent Applications**”).

B. Pursuant to the Contribution Agreement dated January 14, 2009 (the “**Contribution Agreement**”) among Assignee and Assignor, Assignor desires to sell, convey, grant, assign, transfer and deliver to Assignee, and Assignee desires to accept from Assignor, all of Assignor’s right, title and interest in and to the Patents and Patent Applications on the terms and conditions stated in this Assignment.

### AGREEMENT

Assignor and Assignee agree as follows:

**1.** For good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and pursuant to the Contribution Agreement, Assignor unconditionally and irrevocably sells, conveys, grants, assigns, transfers and delivers to Assignee, its successors and assigns, all of Assignor’s right, title and interest throughout the world in and to: (i) all said inventions disclosed in the Patents and Patent Applications (the “**Inventions**”), (ii) the Patents and Patent Applications and any and all other patents of the United States and foreign countries which may be issued for the Inventions, including all priority rights arising from the Patents and Patent Applications, (iii) any currently pending registrations or applications related to the Patents and Patent Applications or the Inventions, (iv) any reissue or reissues, substitutionals, provisionals, continuations, continuations in part and divisions of any of the foregoing, and (v) all claims for damages and equitable relief by reason of past infringement of the Patents and Patent Applications, with the right to sue for and collect the same for its own account.

**2.** Assignor authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents of the United States to recognize this Assignment of the Patents and Patent Applications of the United States to Assignee, and Assignor hereby consents that a copy of this Assignment will be deemed a full legal and formal equivalent of any assignment, consent to file or like document which may be required in any country for any purpose and more particularly in proof of the right of Assignee to claim the benefit of the right of priority provided by any international convention or treaty. Assignor hereby further authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents of the United States and the duly constituted authorities of foreign countries to issue any Letters Patent which may be granted on such inventions, on any applications related thereto, and on any substitute, continuing, divisional, or reissue applications, or any of them, to Assignee, its successors and assigns, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest therein and thereto.

**3.** Assignor further covenants and agrees with said Assignee, its successors and assigns, that upon reasonable written request, without further consideration, Assignor will

execute substitute, continuing, divisional, or reissue applications, amended specifications, or rightful oaths; communicate to Assignee, its successors and assigns, any facts known to Assignor relating to such inventions or the history thereof; execute preliminary statements; testify in any interference or other legal proceedings involving such inventions; execute and deliver any application papers, assignments, or other instruments, and do all other reasonable acts which, in the opinion of counsel for Assignee, are necessary to secure the grant of Letters Patent to Assignee, its successors and assigns, or its nominees, in the United States and in all other countries where Assignee may desire to have such inventions, or any of them, patented, with specifications and claims in such form as will be approved by counsel for Assignee, and to vest and confirm and complete legal and equitable title to all such inventions, applications, and Letters Patent, and to enable it to record such title, without further consideration than now paid but at the expense of Assignee, its successors or assigns.

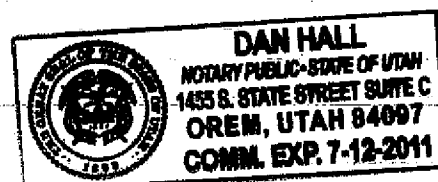
