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## **AGREEMENT**

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October Two thousand and five

### **BETWEEN:-**

- (1) Matthew Alan Gregory of 19 Riddy Lane, Bourn, Cambridge, CB3 7SP (hereinafter called "the Inventor") of the one part; and
- (2) Biotica Technology Limited whose principal place of business is at Chesterford Research Park, Little Chesterford, Nr Saffron Walden, Essex, CB10 1XL, hereinafter called "the Assignee" of the other part.

### **WHEREAS:-**

- (A) The Inventor has made the invention ("the Invention") described in patent application PCT/GB2005/003158 and related applications ("the Patents").
- (B) The Invention was made by the Inventor in the course of his duties as an employee of the Assignee and in circumstances where the Invention belongs to the Assignee.
- (C) The parties wish to enter into this Agreement in order to confirm the vesting of all rights in the Invention in the Assignee.

### **NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED**

#### **1 Assignment**

- 1.1 The Inventor agrees and acknowledges that the Invention was made by him in circumstances where the rights in the Invention belong to the Assignee as a matter of law.
- 1.2 In the premises and in consideration of the sum of £1 now paid by the Assignee to the Inventor (the receipt of which the Inventor acknowledges) the Inventor HEREBY ASSIGNS with full title guarantee absolutely to the Assignee free from any encumbrances all his rights in and relating to the Invention (to the extent that the same may not have vested automatically in the Assignee) including, without limitation:-
  - 1.2.1 the right to apply for, prosecute and obtain patent or similar protection throughout the world in respect of the Invention;
  - 1.2.2 the copyright, design right and rights in the nature of copyright and design right throughout the world in any drawings, designs, models, prototypes or other items embodying or relating to the Invention for the full term of copyright and design right in such items including any renewals, extensions or reversions of such term;
  - 1.2.3 the right to apply for, prosecute and obtain registered design or similar protection throughout the world in respect of such drawings, designs, models, prototypes or other items.

TOGETHER WITH all rights and powers arising from the rights assigned under this clause 1 ("the Rights") including the right to sue for damages and other remedies in respect of any infringements committed prior to the date of this Agreement.

2 **Further Assurance**

- 2.1 The Inventor agrees that at the request and cost of the Assignee he will at all times hereafter do all such acts and execute all such documents (including the making of or deposing to any declaration or oath) as may reasonably be necessary or desirable to secure the vesting in the Assignee of the Rights.
- 2.2 The Inventor agrees that at the cost of the Assignee he will render all such assistance of which he is capable as may be required by the Assignee for the purpose of obtaining patents or other registered protection in respect of the Invention, in support of any action for infringement of any patents or other rights subsisting in respect of or relating to the Invention and in any proceedings in which the validity of any such patents or other rights is put in issue.
- 2.3 Without prejudice to the generality of the confidentiality obligations owed by the Inventor to the Assignee under his employment contract with the Assignee, the Inventor agrees that he will not, without the prior written permission of the Assignee, disclose the Invention or any information relating to the Invention to any other person whatsoever PROVIDED ALWAYS that, should the Inventor's employment by the Assignee come to an end, this obligation shall not, following such termination, apply to any information that is or becomes generally known to the public other than through the act or default of the Inventor or is disclosed to the Inventor without obligation of confidence by a third party who has not derived it directly or indirectly from the Assignee or the Inventor.

3 **Warranties**

The Inventor warrants, represents and undertakes to the Assignee that:

- 3.1 the Specification describes the Invention to the best of the Inventor's ability and he has handed over to the Assignee all documents, notes, correspondence, drawings, models, prototypes and other items relating to the Invention;
- 3.2 he believes he is the true and first inventor of the Invention;
- 3.3 he is the sole beneficial owner of the Rights;
- 3.4 he has not granted any licences or permissions to use the Invention or suffered any of the Rights to be the subject of any charge, mortgage or other encumbrance;
- 3.5 he has not done and is not aware of anything which may prevent patents being granted in respect of the Invention or cause any such patents to be invalid;


4 **General**
