Assignor further authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to record ownership of the Assigned Patents as the property of Assignee.

Assignor agrees on behalf of itself, its directors, officers, employees, agents, successors, assigns, and legal representatives to execute any and all papers and instruments and to do any and all acts which may be necessary or reasonably requested by Assignee, in order to carry into full force and effect this sale, assignment and transfer,

including without limitation to vest in Assignee or its assigns title in and to the Assigned Patents. Without limiting the foregoing, Assignor will communicate to the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to it respecting the improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid the Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for the improvements in the United States.

This Patent Assignment may be executed and delivered (including by facsimile transmission or otherwise electronically) simultaneously in counterparts, each of which when executed will be deemed an original but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument.

This Patent Assignment shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the United States in respect to patent issues, and in all other respects, including as to validity, interpretation and effect by the internal laws of the State of New York applicable to agreements made and to be performed entirely within such State.
