MARITAL PROPERTY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is between John A. Kaftan ("husband") and Georgiana Kaftan ("wife"), of DePere, Wisconsin, alternatively referred to as the "parties" to this agreement.

R E C I T A L S:

WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement are currently husband and wife and are making this agreement with the intention of maintaining and furthering their marital relationship; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to contract with each other concerning the classification of their property under the Wisconsin Marital Property Act (the "Act") and concerning the disposition of their property in the event of the death of either of them;

NOW, THEREFORE, with the express intention that this agreement be legally binding, the parties revoke all prior agreements and agree as follows:

I. CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY AS MARITAL PROPERTY

All real or personal property now owned or hereafter acquired by the parties shall be classified as marital property. If any such property is titled to the parties as joint tenants with right of survivorship, or as survivorship marital property, the property shall be classified as survivorship marital property.

II. TRANSFER OF PROPERTY AT DEATH WITHOUT PROBATE

Pursuant to the provisions of sec. 766.58(3)(f), Stats.:

A. Upon the death of the first party to die, all of the parties' household goods, furniture, fixtures, appliances, tools, vehicles, jewelry, clothing, and other personal effects shall pass without probate to the surviving spouse. However, either spouse by a written memorandum may designate a specific beneficiary for any item of tangible personal property. Upon the death of the second party to die, any of these items that are owned outside of trust by the surviving party shall pass without probate to the trustee of the John and Georgiana Kaftan Revocable Trust dated DEC. 27, 2001, to be held and distributed according to the terms of the trust as originally written and any amendment made to it before the surviving party's death.

B. Upon the death of the first party to die, all of the remaining property owned by the parties together or by either party individually (except such items as will pass by contractual beneficiary designations) shall pass without probate to the

surviving party. However, any property disclaimed by the surviving spouse shall pass without probate to the Trust for Disclaimed Property established under the John and Georgiana Kaftan Revocable Trust dated DECEMBER 27, 2001.

C. Upon the death of the second party to die, all of the remaining property owned by the second party outside of trust except such items as will pass by contractual beneficiary designations) shall pass without probate to the trustee of the John and Georgiana Kaftan Revocable Trust dated DECEMBER 27, 2001 to be held and distributed according to the terms of the trust as originally written and any amendment made to it before the surviving party's death.

III. GOVERNING LAW

This agreement shall at all times be construed in accordance with the laws of the state of Wisconsin.

IV. BINDING EFFECT

This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors, and assigns.



V. VOLUNTARINESS

Each party acknowledges that he or she has voluntarily executed this agreement, with full knowledge and information, and that no coercion or undue influence has been used by or against either party in making this agreement. Each party acknowledges that he or she has been advised of his or her right to seek independent counsel. The parties acknowledge that they have, upon their own initiative, requested that only James A. Guyette be involved in the preparation of this agreement.

VI. AMENDMENT

This agreement may be amended or revoked only by a written agreement signed by both parties or their legal guardians pursuant to sec. 880.173, Stats. or agents under a durable power of attorney.




Sir:
